### Foxconn Tech Talk Series Continues with Discussions on Healthcare and Next Generation AI

Business leaders join Foxconn Industrial Internet at Foxconn's North American headquarters in Milwaukee for an event about technological advances and services that Foxconn technology can leverage in Wisconsin

Milwaukee, WI – Foxconn Technology Group (Foxconn) continued the “Foxconn Tech Talks” series with a discussion by Charlie Alvarez, VP of NA Foxconn company DCI Health Technology, and Dr. Ali Dashti, AI Scientist of Foxconn Industrial Internet. As Foxconn develops its Wisconsin operations, ABC technology (Artificial Intelligence, Big Data and Cloud Computing) is driving systemic change that improves the quality of healthcare.

Before an audience of industry leaders, Dashti addressed the ways in which Foxconn can capture and access Artificial intelligence, Big Data and Cloud Computing. When combined, ABC technology can improve the way physicians collect data to inform decision-making with patients. During medical imaging, for example, AI algorithms and high resolution cameras can read image data with greater accuracy, which informs diagnosis, and speed, which allows for more physician to patient interaction.

Foxconn is also a driver of systemic change within the healthcare industry through data

science. Alvarez explained how continuous data capture, either by imaging or sensors, not only determines diagnosis but can produce predictive analytics that influences preventative-care measures.
